### We Deserve a Better MMWD Fee Plan

Current MMWD proposal is reverse Robin Hood

- Fees should be fairly spread across payers
- MMWD debt-funded \$200 million past 10 years should debt-fund ~\$200 million next 10 years
- We must *equitably* fund MMWD's infrastructure



#### What's Wrong with MMWD's CMF Plan

Based on meter size, not usage. Unfair to Water
Conservers. Adds \$27 to each bill (5/8") -\$68 (1")

 20% of customers--1-inch meters---get 150% increase over 5/8-inch but average only 80% more usage



#### What's Wrong with MMWD's CMF Plan

• Bigger than need be b/c of PayGo---Should use debt, longterm, as are the assets being funded. Lower annual cost

 Developed in the dark w/o broad community input and no ratepayer advocates Involved

• Will go on property tax bill, crowding out other services

#### **CO\$T Offers a Fair CMF Solution**

• Tie CMF to usage. Equal charge for all customers--- \$1.65/CCF.

 Put it on water bills. Transparent, unlike on Property Tax. Avoids taxpayer "tax exhaustion" and crowd-out concerns of taxing jurisdictions.

• Raise or lower CMF annually to deliver targeted infrastructure dollars

• Conduct an inclusive process to vet new rate/fee plan & uses

• New prop 218 notice and hearing

#### The 4%/Year Rate Increase

• MMWD's forecast rate revenues will rise from \$77.7 million currently to \$94.5 million over 5-years (*excluding the CMF*) or \$16.8 million---22%

 Personnel expenses---salaries and fringe benefits—are forecast to rise from \$48.1 million to \$59.8 million or \$11.7 million---24%



#### The 4%/Year Rate Increase

- Pension contribution increases from \$7.7 million to about \$12 million; account for ~35% of the increase in personnel expense growth
- Pension contribution grows to over 10% of total budget
- Employee salaries drive pension benefits. Healthcare insurance costs are additional burden. Control of these costs is critical. They are major source of ratepayers' rate increase.
